

PORTAL ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY

Scope of the Policy

The policies and procedures detailed here apply to transactions made on our portal.

The Information We Collect

This notice of disclosure regarding our information collection policies applies to all information collected or submitted on our portal.

IP Addresses and Header Information

Our servers, like many servers on the World Wide Web, log information site-wide regarding each user's IP address and/or domain name. This information is contained in an HTTP Header, and is passed to us each time a user requests a page or image from one of our sites. There is no personal information gathered by us or passed to us by the HTTP header.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that you may allow us (via your web browser settings) to place on your hard drive. It does not endanger your privacy, your computer, or the personal information stored there. Cookies are perfectly harmless and no web server on the Internet can retrieve cookie information unless it is the one that put it there.

The Way We Use Information

Now that we have discussed the information that we collect about you, we would like to explain what we do with it all.

IP Addresses and Header Information

Although the information passed to us in an HTTP header is of a non-personal nature, many of the things we can track are vital to our ability to bring you a high quality portal that you can enjoy and navigate easily. For example, we may use the information we gather from headers as a temporary identifier to store the history of a portal visit. We may also compile and use the data in the HTTP header and the IP address for marketing and strategic planning purposes.

Personal Information

If a user emails us regarding an issue, we will reply to the email with the intention of providing the information requested by the user. If a user fills out one of our forms regarding a question or request for information, we will reply to the request via email or phone. At no time will we sell or use your personal information for any other purpose whatsoever without also providing you an opportunity to opt out of or otherwise prohibit such unrelated uses. Cookies

We may use cookie technology to recognize a returning user and maintain the user's individual settings, if applicable.

Customer Email Policy

We may, however, email our customers in response to requests for services and information. We may also periodically update our customers on our products and services.
